# **Check Registration Status**

Contact your County Clerk to verify your registration is current.

Register to vote in-person at the County Clerk or by mail



## **Decide to Vote**

Decide when, where and how you will vote.

Absentee voting is available to all registered Wyoming citizens.



## **Vote Election Day**



Your County Clerk's **Election Office will** publish poll locations

#### **Vote Early**



Vote at your County Courthouse until the day before Election

#### **Vote Absentee**



Request a ballot then return by mail or in person.

Sample ballots with offices, party and names will be published by your County Clerk.

# **Bring ID When You Vote**

Acceptable forms include Driver's License, Passport, Tribal ID, Student ID. A complete list is available at Wyoming's Voter ID Law
